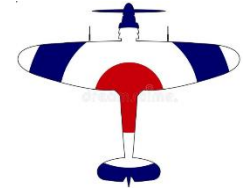


# Keep Calm and Carry on...World War II

## Otter Class Homework Challenges



**PLAY** - Learn to play Battleships with your family - either the traditional way or online!

**CREATE** - Use a shoebox (or other small box) and create a scene from World War II - it could be related to land, air or sea battles, evacuation or home life.

**CODE** - Investigate Morse Code and then write a message to a friend or family member using this new language!

**MAKE DO AND MEND** - Create a toy using only recycled materials!

**NUMBERS** - Find out as many facts about World War II involving numbers as you can (countries, casualties, weapons, aircraft, soldiers, dates...to name but a few!)

**NEWS REPORT** - Design a news report for radio or television that tells people about an incident during the war. Listen to examples on YouTube for inspiration. Then record your final report!

**COOK** - Look up different wartime recipes and create one with your family (adult supervision needed!) Examples might include Woolton Pie, meat loaf, carrot cookies or honey biscuits but there are plenty of others to choose from!

**WRITE** - a diary entry as if you are either a soldier on the front line or a child who has been evacuated. Include what you have seen, heard and how you feel about what is happening.

**RESEARCH** - Use the Internet, library or books to find out and record 10 facts about Anne Frank.
